"that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" Romans 10:9. In a world looking for solutions to the brokenness of human sin, the gospel declares that Jesus is the answer. Through faith in Jesus Christ, God's power can change you. You don't have to live a life of brokenness and bondage, you don't have to be hopeless. Jesus can set you free. Jesus can give you hope.

A Life Lived for God

In the midst of our world's uncertainty, God has given us a sure Word. He has called us to be His holy people. He wants us to live our lives in a way that is radically distinguished from the world around us-set apart with hope, wholeness, and holiness. Followers of Christ recognize the signs of the times and understand that God has placed us here, where we are, for a reason. We are certainly in this world, but we need not be of it.

We should remember that because God is utterly holy, apart from Him we have no innate holiness of our own. In fact, in our natural state, we are unclean, and our righteous acts are the equivalent to filthy rags (*Isaiah 64:6*). These realities underscore the sense and the degree to which God is set apart. This not only applies to us personally, but to everyone throughout time. In contrast to God, no one is righteous, and all are under sin (*Romans3: 9-10*). Despite King David being a man who intimately pursued God, he too sometimes failed miserably (*2 Samuel12:7-1*3). In His actions toward humanity, God is to be feared by the sinful but loved and obeyed by those who seek His forgiveness.
