

- **24** AND WHEN HE HAD GIVEN THANKS, HE BROKE IT AND SAID, "TAKE, EAT; THIS IS MY BODY WHICH IS BROKEN FOR YOU; DO THIS IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME."
- 25 IN THE SAME MANNER HE ALSO TOOK THE CUP AFTER SUPPER, SAYING, "THIS CUP IS THE NEW COVENANT IN MY BLOOD. THIS DO, AS OFTEN AS YOU DRINK IT, IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME."
- 26 FOR AS OFTEN AS YOU EAT THIS BREAD AND DRINK THIS CUP, YOU PROCLAIM THE LORD'S DEATH TILL HE COMES.

The Roman Road

Jesus Christ died for our sins. His death paid the full price for our salvation. Through the death and resurrection of God's own Son, the debt we owed was satisfied. *Romans 5:8*"But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners."

Joy in the Place of Fear

When have you said, "I'm glad that's behind me"? We have days when we want to give up. But there is an end. We have a reason for hope because one day we will rest and enjoy the table prepared for us by Jesus. The prophet Zephaniah reminds us that fear will be a thing of the past in the eternal kingdom of God. Especially inviting is the image that "they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid." Sheep will not relax if they are afraid, and they will not eat if they feel threatened. Yet here are God's people- His sheep- who have had their fill and are contentedly resting. They can do this because they are resting in the presence of their Shepherd. This brings to mind the imagery David painted in **Psalm23:** 2-4: "He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul:... Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me."

God's people will know they have nothing to fear because God is on His throne. God will remove fear from those who humble themselves before Him. When we bow to the right One, we do not need to fear lesser things. God sits on His throne and all fear will ultimately be removed.
