"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord" Romans 6:23. Disobedience to an infinite eternal God deserves an infinite eternal consequence. Neither can a holy righteous God allow sinful man to go unpunished; but God LOVES man whom He has made in His image and He has provided a way of escape by sending His only son to die in our place.

Set Apart: A Life Lived for God

Everybody wants to be free. No one wants to be enslaved to their passions and the baser instincts of human nature. But each of us has experienced times when we fell short of God's best, or, in some cases, exhibited attitudes or behaviors that were completely unbecoming and unacceptable for a child of God. Yet as believers in whom the Spirit of Christ dwells, we are set free from sin's tight grip through the process of sanctification.

As we submit to the control of the Holy Spirit, we increasingly exhibit control over our bodies and its passions. This is whet is meant by Philippians 2:13: "For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure." That is when we begin to experience the type of Christian maturity the apostle Paul described in his letter to believers in the churches of Galatia: "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh" Galatians 5:16. Though we will never be fully successful in overcoming sin, we can reach the point where we consistently obey the promptings of the Holy Spirit and live in the victory Christ intended.
