The Romans Road

"Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ..." Romans 8:1. This is really good news! If you are "in Christ," that means you've put your faith in Him, believing that He died for you and rose again from the dead on the third day (1 Corinthians 15:4). Anyone in Christ is not going to be condemned for their sin and will not go to hell. If that's you, then you don't need to walk around feeling guilty or shameful over your sin once you've believed in Christ because your sin is washed away (1 John 1:7).

Paul and Timothy

The decision by Timothy to accept Paul's invitation to join their missionary endeavor certainly was made with complete knowledge of the dangers faced. No doubt Timothy and his family had either been present or learned of the stoning Paul received on that first visit to Lystra. Yet Timothy responded to God's call through Paul to accompany Paul and Silas on the continuation of their trip. In doing so, Paul would directly mentor Timothy as he walked side by side with him each day of the journey. Timothy would see all aspects of Paul's character, both private and public.

Think about the things you have learned from others that contributed to your spiritual growth. As you pass these on to the person you want to mentor, encourage them to take note of what they are learning. The intent will be that they will one day soon pass those same things on to others. These others, in turn, must be trained and encouraged to continue to pass the torch of discipleship on to the generations to come.
