The Romans Road

You must help people comprehend how true salvation involves being contrite over their sin. Unless a person is ready to repent and turn from their sinful ways, to walk in wholehearted obedience to Christ as their Lord and Master, they cannot be saved. "As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one; there is no one who understands; there is no one who seeks God. All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one" Romans 3: 10-12.

The Lord's Supper and the Purpose of Communion

The Lord's Supper is more than just an ordinance of the Church, more than Christian duty, more than a religious ceremony, and much more than just a portion of a Sunday morning or evening worship service. It's a holy time. It is a practice Jesus instituted and instructed the Church to continue until He returns and we sit together with Him around His table in His Kingdom. But why?

In Luke 22, we find the Lord on His way to Calvary. But before He went to the cross, He paused long enough to share a Passover meal with His disciples. This Passover became a new command and created a new ordinance that Christians in all generations would continue. Today, we continue the practice that Jesus Himself began. The bread is a symbol of the sinless body of Christ and the fruit of the vine a symbol of His pure blood which was shed for the remission of our sins. Christ intended for the practice of communion to be carried out by the Church throughout all ages, remembering His life, His death, and His resurrection, until He comes back again.
